ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

STEP 1 : APPLY FOR PROVISIONAL ADMISSION

- 2) Contact Foreign Student Cell for Admission Request Form. Fill in the details and mail us the following documents. (a) Filled in admission request form with the photograph (b) Valid Passport (c) Marks transcripts of i) High School ii) Bachelor's Degree (if applicable) (d) Previous VISA to India if any
 - (e) Payment details of Processing Fee / Eligibility Fee: Rs.15000 (Non-refundable) (f) Course fees areother than processing fees.

STEP: 2

- 1) All Marks Transcripts have to be attested by Ministry of Higher Education in your country.
- 2) Apply for VISA at the nearest Indian mission or Indian Embassy in your Country.
- 3) You must take an endorsed STUDENT VISA.

Confirmation of Admission

On arrival in India you must report to the 'International Students' Cell to take a firm admission.

Submit the filled in Final Admission form along with the copies of following documents.

ii) Medical Fitness Report / yellow fever

Revised Course for M.A. Social Sciences introduced from the academic year2022-23 with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

General Objectives of the Course:

- 1. To impart high quality of knowledge among the students,
- 2. To prepare the students for variety of challenging careers through innovation in Teaching andresearch.
- 3. To develop comprehensive understanding of interdisciplinary issues of society.

Instructions for M.A. Students

1. Curriculum:

M.A. Course will be divided into four semesters. Examination will be held at the end of each Semester. The course structure has been designed on the basis of credit base with continuous internal evaluation system as per the guidelines of the University Grants Commission, New Delhi. This course includes internal and external evaluation in the ratio of 40:60. The details of the coursestructure have been given below.

2. Duration of Syllabus:-

In case of any change in partial or full syllabus of the course, the examination of the previous syllabus will be conducted only for three consecutive times and the repeaters should clear their backlog of the previous syllabus within these three examinations.

Schedule of Examination and Evaluation:- (Credit Based Semester System) Both, regular and external students for M.A. course should note that a new Choice Base Credit System (Semester Pattern) is being introduced with effect from the academic year 2022-23. The student must appear for 20 papers in two years. They should contact their respective departments to get the syllabus and necessary information. The term-end examination will be based on theory syllabus and will be held at the end of each Semester.

The scheme of the examination will be divided into internal and external
The scheme of the examination will be divided into internal and external
assessment for 40% and 60% marks respectively. The minimum passing
marks in each mode of evaluation will be 40%.

60 marks for term end examination and 40 marks for internal assessment

	(Total 100 marks per paper), internal assessment will be done in four stages in each semester as a process of continuous and comprehensive assessment. Student can give backlog of internal and external examination as per the rules. There shall be revaluation of Semester end examination (Theory examination) but not internal assessment papers. However, internal
	assessment answer books may be shown to the students concerned.
4.	Course and Papers for M.A. (Regular) Two year Program Four Semester Five Papers Per Semester Twenty Papers for entire course. 2000 marks for entire program. Three Groups of Papers: Group 1 - Core Papers (Three Papers) Group 2 - Subject Specific Elective Papers (Any One Paper) Group 3 - Skill Enhancement Course /Generic Paper (Any One Paper) Method of Internal Assessment: Four Assignments per paper, Four Book Reviews, Four Article Writing per paper, Four Article Reviews, Four Classroom Presentations / Four Participation in Seminar conferences, Four Group discussion, Involvement and participation relates with the discipline. Concern faculty will allot an assignment; decide the nature of work accordingly. After the continuous and comprehensive assessment of the student, faculty will give his Grade or Marks Out of 40 marks. Note: Students must contact the department at the beginning of the semester for the selection of internal assessment method.
6.	Examination Instruction For Repeater Students
	Students who have a backlog of the 1^{St} year papers have to fill the backlog form and the fees. Students who have a backlog of the 2^{nd} year have to fill the backlog form and the fees.
	Students who have a backlog of both years (1st year and 2nd year) have to fill the backlog from and the fee.
	Backlog Forms are available in the Post Graduate Department of Nehru Institute of Social Sciences for Regular students & Backlog forms are available in the External Education Department for External students.

7. Examination Instructions

Vidyapeeth examinations are conducted according to the examination time-table notified by the Vidyapeeth by the end of each semester / year. Students are required to appear for written as wellas internal evaluation / oral / practical examination as per the course syllabus of their subject.

8. Revaluation & Rechecking / verification of Marks

Candidates may apply for revaluation or rechecking of marks by paying the Revaluation fee or Rechecking fees. Students should submit the rechecking / revaluation form within 15 days after the declaration of the result.

9. Class Improvement

Choice Based Credit System was introduced from the year 2015-16 onwards and is currently operational. After passing (all 20 papers) of the M. A. examination, if the students does not get II class he shall be allowed to improve the class of minimum of one or maximum of three papers of both the years under the Class Improvement Scheme of the Vidyapeeth.

10. Results

Results of the Vidyapeeth examinations are declared within 40 days after the end of the examination. The Vidyapeeth has the right to reserve the result of a student if he / she has not cleared his / her / other dues.

- Validity of Registration is upto 5 years from the academic year of registration.
