2. File must be in Microsoft Word format with 1.5 line spacing in A4 size page.
3. The font of manuscript must be Times New Roman with 12 font size.
4. The final paper should not be more than 2000 words.
4. First page must be a title page. List all the authors with their organizational affiliation, contact number and e-mail id of corresponding author.
5. The submission must not be published elsewhere or submitted for publication.
6. All manuscript must include a maximum 250 words abstract, next to the title page. Add about 4 to 5 keywords one line below the abstract.
  1. The manuscript should not exceed 08 pages, including references & annexes.
  8. Figures must be in high resolution & clear with descriptive heading.
  9. If the manuscript is accepted for publication, authors transfer the copyrights to the Journal.
